Eligibility

- Candidates must reside in Cranbury.
- Candidates shall be male or female between the ages of 12 to 18.
- Candidates shall have exhibited exceptional community service, which shall include volunteerism, leadership or other virtues of service.

Nominations

- Candidates can be nominated by anyone without exception.
- Solicitations of nominations will be made to Cranbury School, Princeton High School staff, BSA and GSA leaders, and local clergy.

The Award

- A final candidate shall be chosen and agreed upon by the Scholarship and Award Selection Committee. This final candidate shall be presented to the Cranbury Lions Board of Directors no later than the May Board of Directors Meeting for final approval.
- The recipient shall receive the amount of \$250.
- His or her name will be inscribed on the Stan Thomas Community Service Plaque to be displayed by the Cranbury Lions.
- The Honoree, and his or her Parents, will be invited to attend a Lions meeting, where the award will be presented.
